POLICY STATEMENT FOR SCHOLARSHIP PROBATION

At the end of each term/semester, when grades are available, the recipient must bring in a complete college transcript listing GPA and credits to the Scholarship Administrator. At this time, transcripts will be reviewed before scholarship payment will be issued. If a recipient drops below the scholarship's required GPA (example: 2.0 GPA/2.5 GPA/3.0 GPA), or does not maintain (pass) twelve credits, he or she will be placed on probation for one term/semester. However, a scholarship payment will be granted during the probationary period.

At the end of the probationary period, circumstances will be reviewed. An extension of the probationary period will not be granted unless the college transcript indicates an improvement in grades or student has extenuating circumstances, explaining the need for an extension. Examples could include: medical/health issue during school (documentation is required), personal issue with family, such as a death, etc.
