 The Iron Mountain Elementary School Success Coach is to engage, and support identified students (henceforth described as "identified students" and/or "students on caseload" – identified by the Michigan Department of Education; Section 31a Program for At-Risk Pupils) in reaching academic, behavior, and school success. Working within a tiered system of intervention strategies, activities and support may include individual plans to facilitate achievement, working with students in reaching academic, behavioral, and attendance goals, working with school faculty and staff, and working with parents/guardians to assist students in reaching an ultimate goal of school success. Within a tiered system of support, the Success Coach will provide assistance to identified students, individually and/or in groups, regarding work completion, behaviors, attendance, and other academic/social/emotional barriers that may interfere with school success.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

• Four-year bachelor's degree preferred, two-year associate degree required
