We received notification from Dickinson-Iron District Health Department that someone associated with our school district has tested positive for COVID-19. While we must protect the privacy of the person involved, we believe it is best to communicate transparently with you so you can make well-informed decisions for your family.

There is nothing more important to the IMPS than the safety and health of our students, our staff and their families. We are working directly with county health officials to address this situation and are working as quickly as possible. If your child is considered a contact, you will be notified by the health department. We have provided all necessary information to assist them in this process. If you are not contacted by the health department it means your child is not considered a contact.

Although there is no way of tracing the initial exposure to COVID-19, we at Iron Mountain Public Schools are working hard to continue to clean and disinfect all of our buildings as best as possible to protect the safety and well being of our students.
