

Commonly Asked Questions Concerning Kindergarten and Early Kindergarten

Does my child need any special supplies?

Supply lists for each class will be posted in local stores during the summer.

Does my child need any special clothing?

Tennis shoes are required for Physical Education. Children should be sent to school with outside clothing that they can button, zip, or put on independently.

What is the bus schedule?

Bus schedules are provided before the school year begins each fall. Parents will be contacted by school personnel to learn the location and times for those students who require transportation.

Will there be transportation for my child?

Transportation is provided for students who live outside of the neighborhood school that his/her child attends.

How many students are in a class?

20-25, as has been in the past

What is taught in Kindergarten?

Literacy, Health, Math, Science, Computers, Social Studies, Art, Music, and Physical Education

What is the difference between Early Kindergarten and Kindergarten?

Kindergarten is more structured in subject areas required to be master upon entering 1st Grade.

Why do I need to label my child's clothing?

Often students wear identical clothing items to school, or take the wrong clothing home.

What if there is a school delay or cancellation of school?

Parents will receive a text message, phone call, and or an email. Parents can also listen to the local radio and TV stations for delays and cancellation information.
