

Dear Parents,

Children must be five years of age on or before September 1, 2022 to enroll in Early Kindergarten or Kindergarten. If a child residing in Iron Mountain is not five years of age on September 1 but will be five years of age no later than December 1, the parent or legal guardian may still enroll the child in kindergarten for the current school year, (2022-2023). Parents or legal guardians must notify the school district by way of a completed Kindergarten Age Waiver for children born between September 1 and December 1, 2022 to be enrolled in Kindergarten for the 2022-2023 school year.

Michigan Law **requires** that all children have the following before entering school:

Vaccines:

Please bring your child's **birth certificate, immunization record, and two proofs of residency** to Registration.
