**BOARD MEETINGS**

The Board of Education of the School District of the City of Iron Mountain welcomes your attendance and participation at its Board Meetings. By reading this, we hope to explain the rules of Public Participation. We want you to feel comfortable while you are participating and find your attendance informative. Agendas for the Regular meeting will be posted on the front page of the website ([www.imschools.org](http://www.imschools.org)) prior to the Regular and Special Meetings. For Virtual attendance, any comments/questions for the Board can be sent to [haganl@imschools.org](mailto:haganl@imschools.org) by noon on the day of a Regular/Special meeting or by 9 a.m. on the day of a Committee Meeting. If you wish to address the Board directly during the virtual meeting, submit your name and address for the record to [haganl@imschools.org](mailto:haganl@imschools.org) before the start of the meeting and the Virtual Meeting link will be shared with you. If you wish to address the board in person at the meeting, fill out the Public Participation Form and give it to the President prior to the start of the meeting. The President will then invite you to address the Board during the time for Public Comment. The Board of Education encourages all members of the District to participate in the School District Board Meetings. Thank you for taking the time to become more informed about Iron Mountain Public Schools.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AS A PART OF THE AGENDA**

The Board of Education recognizes the value of public comment on educational issues and the importance of allowing members of the public to express themselves on District matters.

Any person or group wishing to **place an item on the agenda** shall register their intent with the Superintendent **no later than six (6) calendar days prior to the meeting** and include:

- A. Name and address of the participant;
- B. Group affiliation, if and when appropriate;
- C. Topic to be addressed.

Such request shall be subject to approval of the Superintendent and the Board President.
